“Engineering the First Year” All schools face common problems recruiting, retaining, and educating students. The first year is particularly critical. Papers and presentations addressing the following topics are particularly welcome:

- Recruiting students from high school.
- Retaining students in engineering, especially early in their education.
- Best practices in first year teaching: how do you do it? Share your experiences.
- Best practices in curricular design: what does your first year look like?
- Transfers between community colleges and 4-year colleges and universities. These students have two “first years”.

Other Topics are welcome, including Recruitment and retention of women and minorities, curricular updates, undergraduate laboratories, internships, co-ops, and job placement.
