Submit your 300-500 word abstract online via ASEE's Monolith system. To access the site, login to the website and click on "Upcoming Conferences." Upload your abstract; please note that it needs to be in .pdf format. **Before** you submit, please check the author's kit for important information.

Updates and information regarding Monolith and deadlines are available from the page.

Please note that ETD is a publish-to-present division. Acceptance of abstracts in the division does not ensure publication in the conference proceedings or presentation at the conference. All accepted peer-reviewed papers, based on the abstracts, must be approved prior to inclusion in the proceedings and before presentation at the conference.

The deadline for submission of abstracts is October 16, 2017. Please take the time to submit your work so your peers can learn from what you're doing.
